FREE hot breakfast, indoor self-parking across the street \$7.00 a night (discounted), FREE hospitality room, a patio with fire pit and grill, Free Wi Fi, fitness center, free shuttle to and from Airport and within a 3 mile radius. Full and self-service laundry. We can bring our own beverages and snacks to the hospitality room. It is within a couple blocks from the \$325 million dollar River Front project, 3 parks leading to the Missouri River, an experience in itself.
